Winemaking

Piedra Sagrada follows a classic Médocain approach with no filtration. Each of the 7 vineyard plots is vinified separately in small, truncated stainless steel vats (5,000L) using only native yeasts. Terroir specialist **Éric Verdier** personally selects and blends the final cuvée, which is then aged for 13 months in new French oak barrels from Marsannay, Le Bois du Roy.

Tasting note

This vintage reveals Cabernet Sauvignon at its most opulent — rich, dense, and expressive — yet elevated by the profound influence of its terroir, which transforms the tannins into a silky, refined texture. The result is a wine of striking elegance, with a deep garnet-black hue and a nose of candied red fruit, warm spices, cedarwood, cloves, and a whisper of violet.

The palate confirms the promise of the nose: layered, lingering, and effortlessly graceful.
